

Field Notes: Tobati, Paraguay

In April I concluded an expansive visit to Tobati, visiting a plethora of sites around the town including several worksites, the Macchi Institute, and the hospital, as well as spending a few days sitting in on various classes at the institute.

The effect of Posterus contribution to the Macchi Institute was immediately felt, and underscored how the institute is improving educational standards in the town, and the amount of progress that contributions from the donors of Posterus can make, even in miniscule amounts.

The additional computer equipment was under constant use and in high demand, as were the overall resources available in the Library.
