Dear Representative of the Posterus Foundation,

Thank you very much for your warm donation of US\$5000- that you provided us for the construction of our new school building. After a long term, it was at last completed and village children began to study in the new school building with joyful heart.

We apologize sincerely for making you impatient with slow pace of construction. As our school area is remote from any town and it was the first time for our village teachers to manage the real building, works on the process of construction did not go smoothly. However, for the first time in the village, the brick building was constructed nicely.

At our Utter Bakchar Primary School, 286 village children (including kindergarten) are studying now dividing into two sessions in the morning and in the afternoon. In Bangladesh literate rate is under 50% and in our rural villages most of parents cannot read and write. However their children now have been given chance to receive education because of our schools. By providing gifted students living in poverty with the opportunity to finish school, we believe that they will have the opportunity to support their families in the future and to break the cycle of poverty they often lived in for generations.

Thank you very much again for your timely donation to construct the new school building, and please receive expression of heartfelt thanks to you from our children and village people.
